YOUTH COUNSELLING (11-25)

Our highly trained counsellors can offer up to 6 free sessions to young people. We also give opportunities to placement counsellors who can counsel lower-risk clients. Due to excessive demand, the waiting list from referral to the first session is currently 4 months, and we are always looking for ways to reduce this and increase funding to gain more counselling hours. Mentoring Services (10-19)

YPI provides up to 12 sessions of free mentoring to young people, offering a confidential and safe space for young people to talk to a professional mentor about their worries, concerns and difficulties. We can support a wide range of areas such as self-esteem, school or family issues, social skills and friendship issues. We aim to equip young people with tools and strategies to increase their emotional health and improve their overall well-being.

They raised an amazing £240 for YPI and made some amazing cakes








